

CLEAN UP DAYS for RESIDENTS OF HALIFAX TOWNSHIP AND HALIFAX BOROUGH!!

Dates for cleanup will be Friday, May 10th from 7 a.m. to 3 p.m., Saturday May 11th from 6 a.m. to 12 noon. Please bring any of your undesirables, excluding household trash, to the Halifax Township's Municipal Building located at 102 Fisher Street.

Guidelines are:

- No contractors, businesses, commercial users or dump truck loads.
- Must be a resident of Halifax Township or Halifax Borough. Identification will be checked.

Examples of bulk items accepted are:

- Metal
- Furniture
- Gas grills (no propane tanks).

A disposal fee will be charged for tires: passenger tires - \$3 each (larger tires will have an additional charge) and tires on wheels - \$6 each.

Unacceptable items:

burn barrels, household weekly trash, paint, propane tanks, chemicals, liquid waste, antifreeze, ammunition, explosives, demolition waste, yard waste and household hazardous waste.

Dauphin County residents may dispose of household hazardous waste by calling 1-800-449-7587.

No liquids of any kind will be accepted (except for used oil)

Absolutely no appliances containing Freon! You must have a certificate showing that the Freon was reclaimed.

NO ELECTRONICS WILL BE ACCEPTED!! They may be taken to Upper Paxton Township the 2nd Saturday of each month.
